Re: City of Menasha Alcohol Operators License Application

Mr. Cory Roehrig

I have reviewed your application for an alcohol operator's license in the City of Menasha and in doing so, it was discovered that there were several issues with your alcohol operators application. The first issue is that you provided inaccurate information on the application. Question #5 asks, have you ever been convicted of any law statute or ordinance pertaining to the use or sale of alcohol (including drinking alcohol underage) and you responded no. However a records check indicates that you have two such violations.

A check of Wisconsin CCAP indicates that you were arrested for an underage drinking violation through the Winnebago County Sheriff's Department on Feb 4, 2009 and subsequently you were convicted of this charge on June 9, 2009.

A Department of Transportation records check indicates that according to your driver's license you have another underage alcohol drinking violation through the Shawano County Circuit Court. These records reflect that you were arrested for underage drinking on July 4, 2009 and subsequently you were convicted of this offense on August 31, 2009.


Under Guideline #4 of the City of Menasha Policy Guidelines for an Operators License you do not qualify for an operator's license in that you provided false information on the application.

In addition you do not qualify for an operator's license under guideline #3 in that you have two or more offenses arising out of separate incidents in the last 7 years for an alcohol beverage offense including underage alcohol consumption.

Based on these circumstances I will be denying your application for an alcohol operator's license in the City of Menasha.

I would like to further advise you that you may appeal this decision, by contacting the Menasha City Clerk's Office at (920)967-3603 within 30 days of this denial to request an appeal before the common council. At this appeal you have the right to be represented and to be heard and to present evidence in favor of granting the license and to rebut the evidence presented in opposition to the granting of this license at a hearing held within 45 days of the filing of such appeal.
