

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS
Wednesday, April 7, 2010 at 10:30 a.m.

Present: Members Greg Keil, Sue Seffker (filling-in for Thomas Stoffel) and City Clerk Deborah A. Galeazzi.

The Board compared the ACCU-VOTE Optic Scan (OS) and Touch Screen Extra (TSX) machines print-out with the return sheets filed and determines and certifies the Aldermanic and Referendum election vote of the April 6, 2010 Spring Election as follows:

Alderman – District 2

Michael E. Taylor – 120

Write-in – 2

Michael E. Taylor having received the highest number of votes cast is hereby declared elected Alderman in District 2 of the City of Menasha for a two year term.

Alderman – District 4

In reviewing the election machine (OS & TSX) result tapes and return sheet for District 4 Alderman, it was unclear to the members of the total number of write-in votes. Chief Inspector of the polling place for District 4, Bernie Sandlin, arrived at 11:00am to clarify the number of write-ins. Mr. Sandlin and the board members checked all the ballots and found one more write-in vote for Jacqueline Miller. It was confirmed by Mr. Sandlin and agreed by the board member that Official Write-in candidate Jacqueline Miller received 29 votes and there was one miscellaneous write-in vote for a total of 30 write-in votes cast. It was then determined and certified by the Board of Canvass as follows:

Mark Langdon – 141

James Taylor – 100

Jacqueline Miller (official write-in) – 29

Kevin Benner having received the highest number of votes cast is hereby declared elected Alderman in District 8 of the City of Menasha for a two year term.



Yes – 1590






