RE: Now Open - Drug Drop

I am pleased to report that drug drop box is now open. This service provides community members a free and safe way to dispose of unwanted medications. As you may recall from my early memo our Community Liaison Officer Aaron Zemlock was able to obtain the equipment for this program through a grant from CVS Pharmacy. The box is now installed at the Police Department at 430 First Street and is accessible 24/7.

The program allows for us to accept the following items:

- Prescription Medication (pill or tablets)
- Prescription Patches
- Over- the- Counter Medications (pills or tablets)
- Vitamins
- Medications for Pets

We are **NOT** able to accept the following items:

- Needles and Sharps
- Liquids or Lotions of ANY kind
- Inhalers
- Medication from Businesses or Clinics
- Aerosol Cans
- Thermometers
