

RESOLUTION R-4-15

Resolution Accepting Gift of Architectural Elements from 175 and 177 Main Street Structures

Introduced by Mayor Merkes

WHEREAS, The Common Council has authority to accept gifts; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to SEC. 2-4-8 of the Code of Ordinances, the City of Menasha has declared as a matter of public policy that the protection, enhancement, perpetuation and use of improvements of special character, special historic interest or value is a public benefit; and

WHEREAS, With the recent demolition of two City of Menasha structures at 175 and 177 Main Street the owners have saved certain architectural elements and are desirous of giving some of them to the City of Menasha for reuse; and

WHEREAS, By the City of Menasha's acceptance of these architectural elements it will serve to safeguard the historic and cultural heritage of these structures for the education and pleasure of the people of the City and foster civic pride in the accomplishments of the past.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Common Council hereby accepts the architectural elements donated by the owners of 175 and 177 Main Street and allows the relocation, storage and reuse of said elements for City purposes.
