F. DISCUSSION

1. Sustainability Board Annual Report and future work plan
 - Board members agreed that emphasis should remain on Energy Use, Waste Management, and Active Communities
2. City of Menasha Energy Usage
 - Baseline electric usage for Public Protection Facility, City Hall, Library, and Public Works Facility; showed significant usage declines since 2007-8. Usage compared to other communities showed Menasha being similar to significantly lower. Goal for 2013 is to see an additional 1% decline in usage compared to 2012. Usage reductions ranged from 1% to 30% at listed buildings, 3% considered good over 5 year period.
3. Waste Management
 - Danielle presented her project as part of Posters in the Rotunda in Madison. The poster will be presented to the Sustainability Board at the next meeting. Danielle will also have information on recycling strategies other communities have used to increase recycling. Menasha is currently at the state average for recycling per capita.
4. City of Menasha recycling event
 - Recycling event is set for April 27th, additional signage needed, handouts for utility tree and ac tune-up should be available for the event.
5. River-Gen Project
 - UW Platteville will be able to work with us on the engineering of the proposal in the fall 2013 semester.
