Our Park Board discussed the idea of having a designated and signed area to allow dogs only during Jazzfest. We discussed several pros and cons, but one question we could not answer was whether Jazzfest really believes that somehow allowing dogs would make their event better. The Board felt that if the request was not made, why would they need to consider it. The city ordinance says dogs are allowed on the trail. I interpret that to mean the owner and dog will be moving on the trail, not sitting down a little bit off the trail to listen to music.
