

Code of Conduct for the Menasha Senior Center

The Menasha Senior Center welcomes all participants and visitors. To ensure a safe, pleasant, and comfortable environment, participants and visitors are expected to behave responsibly, and to respect the rights and dignity of others.

Behavior which inhibits older adults and creates an offensive environment is inappropriate and will be addressed in the proper manner. Inappropriate behavior includes but is not limited to:

- Boisterous
- Disruptive
- Loud or abusive
- Unsafe
- Dangerous or out of control
- Profane or offensive language
- Disorderly conduct, shoving, or hitting
- Sexual or other harassment

Any illegal activities will be reported to the proper authorities. These activities include but are not limited to:

- Theft of any kind
- Damaging of senior center property
- Vandalism of materials, equipment, and building
- Assault
- Use of illegal drugs, selling drugs, etc.
- Indecent exposure
- Violent or threatening verbal or physical abuse

Additional rules and expectations:

- Smoking is prohibited on the premises
- Consumption of alcohol on the premises is prohibited
- Any person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave and arrangements for safe transportation home will be provided
- Center participants are asked to maintain appropriate personal hygiene
- Appropriate attire must be worn
- Participants at the center shall be responsible for the actions of their grandchildren or other minors
- Menasha Senior staff reserve the right to inspect any suspicious looking bags, backpacks, packages etc. and report these to the proper authorities

Participants and visitors violating this code of conduct will be requested to stop the inappropriate behavior and may be asked to leave the senior center premises. Each occurrence will be evaluated on an individual basis and appropriate measures will be taken by senior center staff.
