

RESOLUTION R-16-14  
A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE DESIGN OF THE  
RACINE ROAD, TWELFTH STREET, AND US 10/WIS 441 INTERCHANGE

Introduced by Alderman Sevenich and Alderman Taylor

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) plans to reconfigure the interchange at Racine Road, Twelfth Street, and US 10/Wis 441 as part of the Tri-County Freeway Expansion project including a roundabout, and restricted right in, right out access at Twelfth Street, and lengthened or new median strips; and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will have negative effects to business by unnecessarily limiting access at Twelfth Street; and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will lengthen emergency vehicle response routes to Calder Stadium, with a capacity exceeding 4,000, and the Gegan School neighborhood, at Twelfth Street from the north; and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will create a safety concern by promoting cut through traffic at the PDQ convenience store located at the intersection of Twelfth Street and Racine Road; and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will direct traffic to a congested intersection at Ninth Street and Racine Street unnecessarily, and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will direct traffic to the intersection of DePere Street and Airport Road directly adjacent to Gegan School, increasing safety concerns for pedestrian and bicycling children in the area, and

WHEREAS, the proposed configuration will inconvenience thousands of motorists each year unnecessarily, placing additional wear on local roads, and increasing fuel usage and emissions, and

WHEREAS, alternatives exist including incorporating Twelfth Street into the proposed roundabout;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Menasha supports an alternative design of the interchange at Racine Road, Twelfth Street, and US10/Wis441 that maintains full access at Twelfth Street, for economic, safety, and congestion reasons.





## Project improvements-overview



- Reconstruct 5 interchanges and add missing movements at US 41

- Revise interchange control






