RE: Eliminate angle parking on the 600 block of 2nd Street and restore parallel parking on the south side

The purpose of this neighborhood request is to address public safety.

1. The degree of the angle parking stalls are at too steep of an angle. Traffic heading east on the south side of the 600 block of 2nd Street has to cross the center line to safely pass parked cars.
2. Backing out of the angle stalls is extremely difficult and poses a vision control problem if there is a large vehicle parked next to you.
3. When backing out of the angle parking stall, with a vehicle parked next to you, you have to back across the center line into oncoming traffic to complete this movement.
4. The purpose of the angle parking was to accommodate more parking for St. Mary's High School, the High School has since moved.
5. In recent years, St. Mary's Parish has added off street parking lots which have reduced the need for overflow parking to use the 600 block of 2nd Street.
6. There are many children utilizing the 600 block of 2nd Street - that being St. Mary's Elementary students and those traveling to the Jefferson Park area.
