

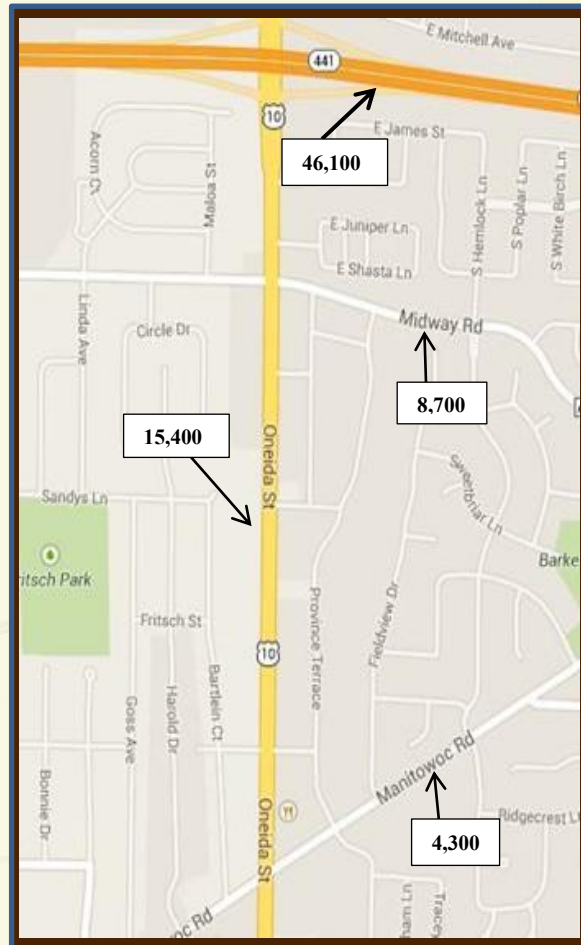
PROVINCE TERRACE
