Notice to voters: This ballot may be invalid unless initiated by 2 election inspectors. If cast as an absentee ballot, the ballot must bear the initials of the municipal clerk or deputy clerk.

Important: Use a #2 pencil or the marking pen provided. Do not use Red Ink!
