


The Menasha Landmarks Commission will be hosting a preliminary planning workshop at **4pm on Thursday, February 27, 2014** for the pedestrian link between the Broad Street Parking Lot and Main Street. As an adjacent property/business owner, it is important to know early in the planning process what your desires and ideas are for the space so we can ensure that the final design will be as multi-functional as possible.
