

Menasha Health Department Inspection Reports

Restaurants / Retail Food

Inspection reports include all observations which were cited during the most recent inspection. Pages 1 & 2 include the status of each inspection section cited as **IN**- in compliance, **OUT** – out of compliance, **NO** – not observed during inspection, **NA** – Not applicable to the establishment. The column labeled **COS** indicates the violation was corrected during the inspection. The column labeled **R** indicates that the violation was a repeat violation cited during the previous inspection. Beginning on page 3 any items which were marked as **OUT** – will be explained including the actual observation, the Wisconsin Food Code section which was the basis for the violation followed by the corrective action required.

Swimming Pools

Inspection reports include all observations which are cited during a swimming pool inspection including water chemistry, facility condition, mechanical equipment condition, and life guard information.

Tattoo & Body Piercing Establishments

Inspection reports include all observations which are cited during a tattoo, body piercing or permanent make-up establishment inspection.

Restaurants Include:

- Restaurants
- Mobile Restaurants

Retail Food Locations Include:

- Grocery Stores
- Convenience stores
- Bakeries
- Take and bake pizza stores
- Ice cream shops
- Retail stores selling food

Swimming Pools include:

- All public swimming pools and whirlpools including apartments

Tattoo Establishments include:

- Tattoo
- Body piercing
- Permanent make-up

Weights and Measures

The City of Menasha weights and measures program includes the testing of all weighing and measuring devices used for commercial transactions including:

- **Gas pumps**

- Standard gas pumps
- High speed diesel pumps
- Vehicle tank meters (example: fuel oil trucks)
- **Scales**
 - Grocery scales
 - Precious metal scales
 - High capacity scales
 - Vehicle scales
 - Pharmacy scales
- **Price scanning systems**
- **Timing devices**
 - Laundromat dryers
 - Car wash vacuums
 - Self service car wash timers
- **Package checking** (sampling of commercial products to ensure that actual product weighs what is declared on the packing and to ensure that the consumer is not being charged for packaging or any other non product components.
 - Pre packed meats in grocery stores
 - Any store packed items
 - Commercially packaged items
- **Counting devices**
 - Aluminum can counters
 - Pharmacy pill counters

Interpreting reports:

Gas pumps – refer to the column labeled **max err** the result for each pump and grade will be listed as either a positive or negative number (-). The tolerance of a vehicle gas pump is +/- 6 cubic inches of fuel (1 cubic inch = ~ the volume of a shot glass). Positive numbers indicate over dispensing of fuel and negative numbers indicate under dispensing of fuel. All tests are based on a 5 gallon sample.

Scales – reference results column which will state either “correct” or “Rejected”. A “rejected” scale was found out of tolerance or some other violation which requires the device being removed from service either permanently or temporarily.

Price Scanning Systems – Reference the **shelf column** and the **Scan column**. **Shelf** and **Scan** should be the same number; errors will be identified as either “over charges” or “under charges”. 98% accuracy is required for all price scanning systems to be in tolerance. The score percentage is cited at the end of the report. Failed reports are given a period of time to make corrections followed by re-inspection to ensure compliance.

Timing Devices – reference result which identifies if the actual time is within tolerance.

Package Checking – refer to result section to determine whether a random sample actual weights were within tolerance to the declared weights. Other violations including failure to take tare and label violations would also be noted.

Counting Devices – reference result section which will indicate whether the actual count was within tolerance.
