For most it is time to "float your boat". Cities along the rivers and lakes are ready to see navigation begin and have summer activities. We are fortunate to have over 100 miles of waterways: The locks are open to Little Chute, Appleton to Lake Winnebago, Fond du Lac to Oshkosh, on the Fox River to Berlin or take the Wolf River to New London.

Each year I have done a couple of events at Menasha Marina. Things have changed a little this year. The marina now has its own green space inside the marina area, where I will hold my events. After this recognition we'll have a lunch and join together to show our appreciation. After, the Coast Guard will be available to do voluntary boat safety inspections. June 15 will be a "Pre-River Run Social" in the marina. On Saturday the 16th we will leave Menasha Marina at 11 am for a guided tour of the open locks. After the tour Appleton Yacht Club will be ready to entertain you with food and music. Load a boat up with friends or join the flotilla and enjoy the day. Sept. 1, the marina's annual Corn Roast. With any of my events I will need reservations, to make sure on boat parking and the number of attendance, 920-967-5193. I look forward to seeing my boating friends again.

The following is informational research to give you a short recap:

The locks and dams along the Fox River to Green Bay were completed in the 1850's. The federal government took control in 1872. The Friends of the Fox started forming in 1982 and by the end of 1983 this group's mission was to try and stop the U.S. Corp of Engineer from leaving the lock system and shutting it down. The locks did shut down the end of the 1987 navigation. The Fox River Navigational System Authority was formed in 2001 and the locks were transferred to the State. The first step for this management group was to begin rehabilitation of the navigational system and continue operation. Soon, another group was formed to coordinate communities throughout the Fox and Wisconsin River system to develop a Heritage Parkway.

For 30 years the dedicated Friends of the Fox goal is to preserve an important piece of our heritage and to continue navigability on the Fox River. Through many fund-raising and planning they continued to keep us aware of the importance of the river and financially have supported large developments pertaining to the river. This past year they have placed 3 kayak/canoe ramps and portages in Menasha and others along the river and help fund the re-opening of the Eureka Lock.

The Authority agency continues the important details of rehabilitation of the lock system. This hasn't been an easy task but their vision continues to complete this project that there will be endless navigation again on the Fox River. The locks are open from Menasha to Little Chute. FRNSA has placed docks for boater to use in Appleton by the Olde Oneida Street Bridge and in Little Chute by the lock gates at Mill Street. Early this summer Kaukauna #4 will be completed and start on the remainder in Kaukauna. As you see in this pamphlet a schedule is set on the opened locks. The FRNSA encourages the use of the locks, which have buoys for navigation. It's a way to acknowledge the accomplishments toward their massive undertaking.

A Fox-Wisconsin Heritage Parkway bill is now working its way through the House of Representatives and Senate to become a National Parkway. The parkway includes rivers and lakes to connect the Great Lakes to the Mississippi River. It consists of 15 counties, 45 river communities and 280 miles in length. Their goal is to promote the history of the river corridor and to increase recreational use on the Fox and Wisconsin Rivers.

Wisconsin Department of Transportation-2012 Bridge Operation and Lock Schedules

For the four bridges in Oshkosh (Main Street, Oregon/Jackson Street, Wisconsin Street and Congress Avenue) and the Winneconne Main Street Bridge, the operational hours will be 8:00am to 12:00-midnight from April 20th, to October 7th. As in the past there will be restricted operation hours for Oshkosh bridges on Monday-Friday to avoid undue conflicts with the street traffic during the following time periods:

(11:45am to 12:15pm)

(12:45pm to 1:15pm)

(3:00pm to 5:00pm)

For the two bridges in Menasha (Racine and Tayco Street), the operation hours will be 8:00am to 12:00-midnight on Friday through Sunday and 10:00am to 10:00pm on Monday through Thursday from April 20th, to October 7th. Operating hours on Memorial Day, Monday, May 28th and Labor Day, Monday, September 3rd will be from 8:00am to 12:00-midnight as on the weekends. **Menasha bridges are now automated from Racine Bridge. NOTE: Racine Street Bridge will NOT be operated on September 23rd from 7:30am to 1:30pm to accommodate the Fox Cities Marathon Route.**

During the off-season, all operable bridges in the system can be opened if at least twelve (12) hours notice is given. Railroad bridges and highway lift bridges can be operational and available in non-operating hours prior to April 22nd and after October 9th. Menasha 967-3621, Oshkosh/Winneconne 232-1713.




