Fox River Navigational System Authority – 2011 Rox River Udate

Since 1988, only three of the seventeen locks between Lake Winnebago and Green Bay (Menasha, Little Kaukauna and DePere) have been in operation. During that time 5,500-6,500 craft carrying 20,000-24,000 persons have traveled through those locks each year. Today with eight more locks and one guard lock have been restored and are operational. New features are the kayak/canoe launch ramps that have been installed: 3 in Menasha and at the Appleton Locks. A 100 foot docking pier west of Olde Oneida Street between Lock 1 and 2 and a 40 foot pier in Little Chute by the Guard Lock. Wisconsin Department of Transportation-2011 Bridge Operation and Lock Schedules

For the four bridges in Oshkosh (Main Street, Oregon/Jackson Street, Wisconsin Street and Congress Avenue) and the Winneconne Main Street Bridge, the operational hours will be 8:00 am to 12:00-midnight from Friday April 22nd-Oct. 9th. As in the past there will be restricted operation hours for the Oshkosh bridges on Monday-Friday to avoid undue conflicts with the street traffic during the following time periods:

(11:45am to 12:15pm)

(12:45pm to 1:15pm)

(3:00pm to 5:00pm)

For the two bridges in Menasha (Racine and Tayco Street), the operation hours will be 8:00 am to 12:00-midnight on Friday through Sunday and 10:00am to 10:00pm on Monday through Thursday from April 22nd to Oct. 9th. Operating hours on Memorial Day, Monday, May 30th and Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 5th will be from 8:00am to 12:00-midnight, as on the weekends. **Menasha bridges are now automated from Racine Bridge. NOTE:** Racine Street Bridge will **NOT** be operated on Sept. 18th from 7:30 am until 1:30 pm to accommodate the Fox Cities Marathon route.

During the off-season, all operable bridges in the system can be opened if at least twelve (12) hours notice is given.

Railroad bridges and highway lift bridges will be operational and available for 12-hour non-operation hours notification prior to April 22nd, 2011 and after Oct. 9th, 2011. Menasha 967-3621, Oshkosh/Winneconne 232-1713.

NOTE: Oshkosh Canadian Railroad Bridge, foundation construction due to start this fall and completion 2013.


