- Sign up for sculpting by February 1, 2010, return forms to the Menasha Parks and Recreation Office, 140 Main Street, 2nd Floor of City Hall. Call 967-3640 for more information
- A team of 2-4 sculptors is optimal, individuals welcome
- A 4'x4'x6' block of snow will be placed along the west side of Smith Park (Cleveland Street) for your team to sculpt, look for your number next to snow block
- Sculpting may begin anytime after 12:00-Noon on Friday, February 5 and ends at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 6
- An expert sculptor will be available (sculpting his own piece) from Friday from 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the Menasha Library. Hot chocolate available.
- Judging held at 3:15 p.m. Saturday, great prizes for winners, goodie bags to all participating teams
- Categories to be judged: Originality Award, Visual Impact Award, Kids Appeal Award and Just 'Cuz We Liked It Award. Our thanks to Alderman Eric Hendricks for making these special awards.

Snow Sculpting Team Rules and Registration

Rules:

1. Sculpture must be made completely from snow*
2. No colorant (like paint, etc.) may be used
3. Spritzing or misting your sculpture to solidify a sculpture is permitted
4. An ice chopper (with chisel edge or a roofing shovel) and small hand tools work well
5. A drawing or photograph of the sculpture to work from is recommended

*Snow covered supporting pieces like wood lath, rebar, or PVC pipe may be used. No plywood, lumber or cardboard. Support pieces will be discarded after the sculpture melts.
