Safe Bicycling Neighborhood Education & Training Course

The course is a compilation of bicycle safety information based on WI statistics which show how children are usually hurt in bicycling situations. It is also a skills course to reinforce the educational information and test proper riding skills and lessons learned.



Who Should attend?

Children ages 6-12 and parents (strongly encouraged)

How do I get this training to my neighborhood?

- Gather a group of 6-10 children or adults
- Confirm they all have bikes and helmets
- Fill out this form and drop it off or mail it to the police department.

Training Covered

- 1) Pre test for bike and pedestrian safety
- 2) Proper helmet fitting for everyone and discuss the importance of wearing a helmet.
- 3) Bike Inspection- Officers will walk the group through a self check. **It is recommended the host have someone available with tools who can assist in minor adjustments if necessary for your group.
- 4) Hand Signals and Pre Ride Briefing.
- 5) Skills test demonstrating safe bicycling skills.
- 6) Short "on street" ride through your neighborhood chauffeured by police safe bicyclist instructors. Officers will point out hazards in your area if discovered.
- 7) Certificates for successful completion and bike registration provided.
