PERMIT STIPULATIONS

_____ hereby agrees to:

1. Indemnify and save harmless the City of Menasha and its officers from all liability for accidents and damage caused by any of the work covered by this permit.
2. Submit with this permit an erosion & sediment control plan along with required fees and guarantees.
3. The Department of Public Works will within 10 business days of the receipt of a complete permit application, inform the applicant whether the application and plan are approved or not approved based on requirements of Ordinance 0-7-08.
4. Notify the Department of Public Works within 48 hours of commencing any land disturbing construction activity.
5. Install prior to commencing work and strictly comply with the erosion control guidelines and requirements set forth in Wisconsin administrative code (W.A.C.) NR 151, the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources runoff management performance standards.
6. All erosion control devices shall at a minimum be inspected weekly and within 24 hours after every precipitation event that produces 0.5+ or greater of rain during a 24 hour period. A file of these written reports shall be kept at the construction site.
7. Allow the Department of Public Works to enter the site for the purpose of inspecting compliance with the erosion & sediment control plan or for performing any work necessary to bring the site into compliance with the control plan.
7. All off-site sediment deposits occurring as a result of construction work or a storm event shall be cleaned up by the end of each day. **Flushing shall not be allowed.**
8. Pay all fines and forfeitures imposed for any violation of any rule, regulation, or ordinance governing any construction work adopted by the Common Council. Applicant to repair any damage done to existing improvements during the progress of construction in accordance with the ordinances, rules, and regulations of the City.
9. Any soil erosion that occurs after final grading and/or the application of stabilization measures must be repaired and the stabilization work redone
10. Erosion control measures shall not be removed until the area(s) served have established vegetative cover.
11. Along with above, comply with all other stipulation set fourth in Ordinance 0-7-08.
