Our last stop of the day is for a **guided tour** of the **Isabel Bloom Harborview Production Studio**. During the tour, we have behind-the-scenes access to every step in the making of each Isabel Bloom sculpture. We'll see how the company maintains the legacy of Isabel Bloom, some of her original art and photos and we learn how her innovations still influence their production process today. As a remembrance of our tour, we will also have the opportunity to purchase exclusive sculptures available only to tour guests.
